DETAILS OF WORK

PBD-5014' KB - Drilled out float collar and cement to 5052'. Dry tested for 2 hours, OK. Loaded hole with 40 bbls. of oil. Perforated with 4 dyna-jets per ft from 4960' to 4974'. Swabbed back 40 bbls of load oil and 20 bbls of new oil. Loaded hole with 118 bbls oil and pump 40 bbls oil into formation - 1975 psi. Sand-fraced w/50,000 lbs sand in 24,400 gal. of oil. Flushed w/150 bbls of oil. Initial treating press-1975 psi, final treating press-1800 psi, final flush press-1975 psi, average injection rate-39.4 bbls/min., 10 min S.I. press-300 psi, total load oil to recover-891 bbls. Swabbed and flowed 891 bbls of load oil back. Flowed 244 bbls. of oil in 16 hours. Loaded hole with 125 bbls of oil. Ran 157 jts. of 2" EUE tbg. with perforated nipple and seating nipple, landed at 4982'. Ran 110, 3/4" x 25' rods, 37, 3/4" x 25' rods with Huber scrapers, 4 pony rods, and 2" x 1 1/2" x 16' pump.
