Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your San Juan 28-7 Well No. 114 to be located 990 feet from the South line and 2250 feet from the West line of Section 22, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as El Paso Natural Gas Company owns all offsetting acreage, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. 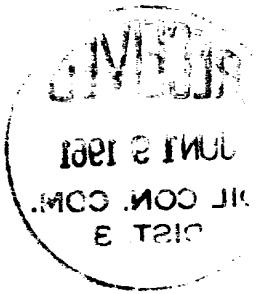
