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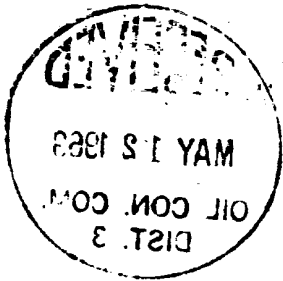

Dear Mr. Porter:

-This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well located in the Basin Dakota Pool.

Unit M
It is intended to locate this well, El Paso Natural Gas Company San Juan 28-5 Unit No. 81, 600' from the South line and 1010' from the West line of Section 26, T-28-N, R-5-W, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The south half of Section 26, consisting of 320.00 acres is dedicated to this well. The topography of the southwest quarter consists essentially of a steep-sided mountain, which would not afford an economical location site to either build or maintain. The portion of the southwest quarter of Section 26, designated "Unit Letter M" is sufficiently level to afford an economical location at the above mentioned footages.

El Paso Natural Gas Company is the operator of the San Juan 28-5 Unit, the proposed drilling block is included in the San Juan 28-5 Unit Dakota Participating Area. The location will be on an interior block, no section boundary of operators not participating in the San Juan 28-5 Unit will be within 790' of the well site.

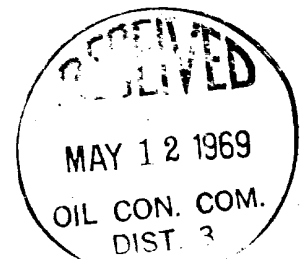
Attached are two copies of the intention to drill and two copies of the certified well location plat.
