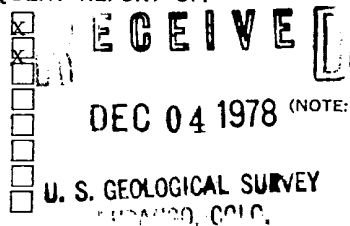

11/16/78: PBTD 7353'. Tested casing to 4000#, OK. Perfed 7150, 7156, 7163, 7169, 7238, 7273, 7279, 7299, 7307, 7319, 7325 with 1 SPZ. Fraced w/ 62,000# 40/60 sand and 71,300 gallons slick water. Flushed w/5000 gallons water.

Instructions
