

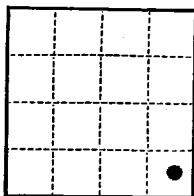

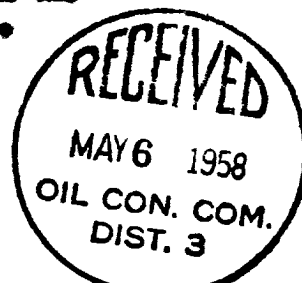

**DETAILS OF WORK**

The Navajo Tribal 71 was spotted 4-28-58 and a 1 1/2" hole was drilled to 229 feet. 3 1/2" surface casing was cemented at 229 feet with 200 sacks and an estimated 50 sacks was circulated. After 24 hours the casing was tested with 1000 psi for 30 minutes with no loss of pressure. On the last day of the month a 1 1/2" hole was being drilled at 1439 feet.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
