Dear Mr. Ramey:

Jerome P. McHugh is requesting administrative approval for downhole commingling of the Fruitland and Pictured Cliffs production in the following wells under the terms of the commission order R-5359:

Chaco Plant #12	I-22-T26N-R12W
Nassau #6	J-36-T27N-R12W
Nassau #7	K-36-T27N-R12W

We anticipate no more than 50 psi difference in bottom hole pressure from the two zones. The Fruitland formation will produce 60% and the Pictured Cliffs will produce 40% of the total production. The recoverable reserves are estimated at 200,000 MCF from the Pictured Cliffs and 150,000 MCF from the Fruitland.
