

Administrative Order NSL-4675

Dear Mr. Cox:



According to the Division's well records the Bolack "C" LS Well No. 7 was initially drilled in 1956 by El Paso Natural Gas Company and completed at a standard gas well location in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool within a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the NW/4 of Section 33.

It is our understanding that XTO Energy, Inc. intends to abandoned the Pictured Cliffs interval and recompleted this well up-hole into the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool. Pursuant to the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the location of this well is considered to be unorthodox. Further, the W/2 of Section 33 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of these special pool rules the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location for the Bolack "C" LS Well No. 7 is hereby approved.
