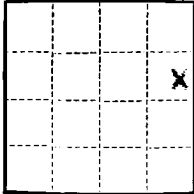

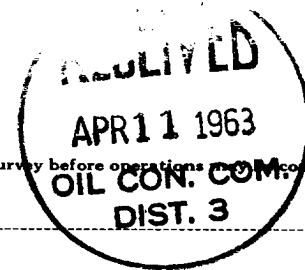

DETAILS OF WORK

Moved in workover rig. Cut 2-1/16 tubing and set retr. BP at 6503'. Squeezed Gallup perms 6267-98 with 150 sx neet. Pumped in at 1500<sup>lb</sup>. Max 4200<sup>lb</sup>. Retrieved RTTS packer and drilled hard cement to 6317'. Tested casing with 3800<sup>lb</sup>. Retrieved BP. Ran overshot and retrieved 2-1/16 fish from packer. Ran 2-1/16 production tubing. 209 joints set at 6794. Bottom of tubing is through model D packer but not packed off. Swab well in and released rig.
