DETAILS OF WORK

On September 21, 1952, 5-1/2" casing was landed at 1650 feet and cemented with 75 sacks of cement. Plug down at 11:25 P.M., September 21, 1952. At 4:00 P.M., September 23, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 600 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Thirty-two feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 600 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
