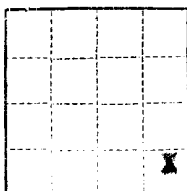

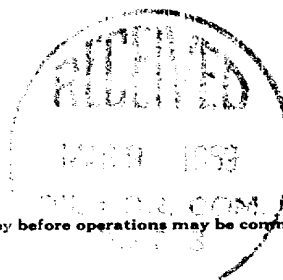

DETAILS OF WORK

Jack Frost "B" Well No. 1 was spudded on February 26, 1959 and on February 27, 1959, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 490' with 390 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 800 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure. Reduced hole at 490' to 8-3/4" and resumed drilling operations.
