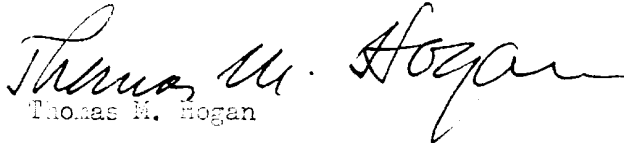
Dear Sir:

Dear Mr. Hogan:

In your letter of June 20 directed to the various offices of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, Western Development Company and Southern Union Gas Company, you advised that the correct pool location for your Douthitt Federal #2 well is East Kutz Fruitland instead of the Gallegos Fruitland pool heretofore indicated in your monthly operators report.

Due to the present confusion and conflict between the Astec of the Commission and the New Mexico Engineering Committee concerning the proper pool identification for this well, we recently wrote Mr. Steve Uts, Chief Engineer for the Commission in Santa Fe, requesting clarification of the matter. In his reply, Mr. Uts advised that the well was completed in the Gallegos Fruitland pool and we have placed the well in our records accordingly. 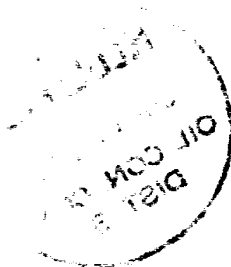
