DETAILS OF WORK

1. Spudded 5/10/51.
2. Set 3 joints or 100' of 9-5/8" OD, 29.3#/ft., 8 rd. thd., casing at 106' KB with 60 sacks of regular cement and circulated to surface.
3. Tested casing with 500# pressure held for 30 minutes and showed no drop in pressure.
4. After drilling plug, tested for 30 minutes with 300#. The water level remained stationary.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
