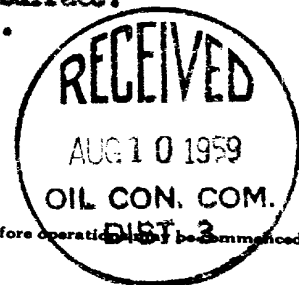
DETAILS OF WORK

- Cement 1st stage w/600 sacks
- Cement 2nd stage w/150 sacks

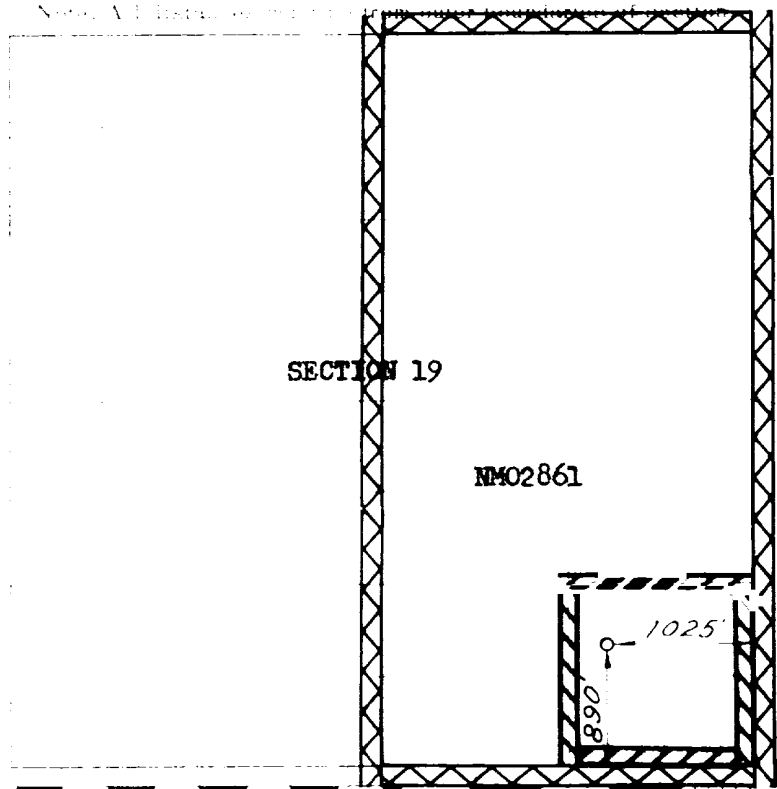
