2. Furnish copies of all logs.

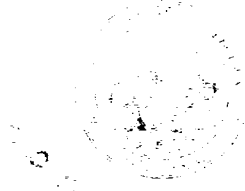
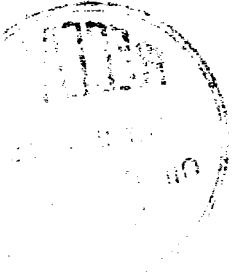

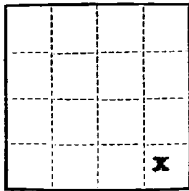

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)
Propose to run 3 1/2" casing to 1000 ft. then drill with rotary tools to the top of the Pictured Cliffs formation. Cementation will be done between 1,900 feet and 2,200 feet below surface. Completion will consist of sand and sand oil fracturing or shooting with solidif. or other equivalent as warranted.

Casing program: 30 feet of 3 1/2" cas. 5 lb. 20# casing. Circulate cement to surface using at least 20 sacks of cement.

6-1-2" 100 lb. 4-55 steel case pipe to be set on top of Pictured Cliffs formation. Cementation will be 100 sacks regular cement.

On casing 2 1/2" test hole and check for depth for production.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

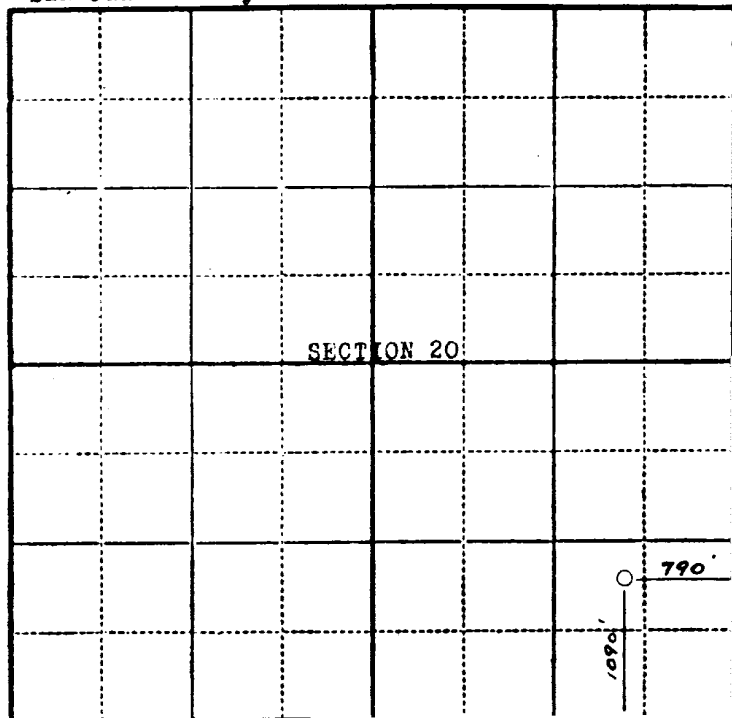
