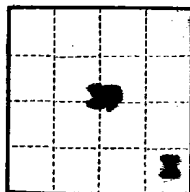

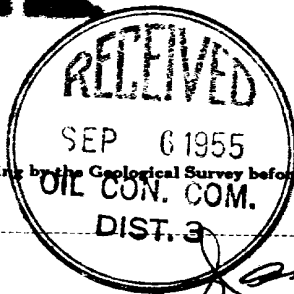

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is intended to drill a well through the Natural Little Sandstone on the above location.

A 20 3/4" hole will be drilled with rotary tools and 100' of 9 5/8" - 20 surface casing will be set with the cement circulation well. A 2 3/4" rotary hole will be drilled to 2000' and/or the top of the P.A. Sandstone. 7" - 20 production casing will be set at this point. A 6 3/4" hole will be drilled through the P.A. Sandstone with cable tools and a small flow stimulant added to this case. If tubing will be used to complete this case.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
