DETAILS OF WORK

Drill 12 1/4" hole to approximately 200'. Set 8-5/8" casing at approximately 200' and circulate cement to surface.
 Drill 6-3/4" (or larger) hole to total depth at approximately 6765'. (Cut 50' core in the Dakota at approximately 6550', and drill stem test.)
 Log, and set 4 1/2" casing at total depth and two-stage cement to cover Dakota, Gallup, Pictured Cliffs formations.
 Complete in Dakota only.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

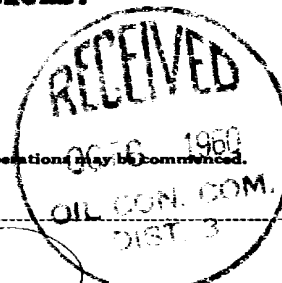
