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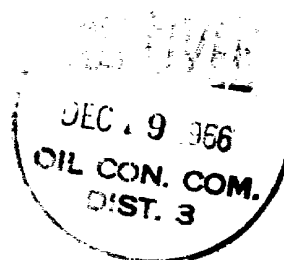

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for special authority to produce up to 500 MCF of gas per month from your Turner B Com D Well No. 9 located in Fulcher Kutz Pool, Unit D, Section 16, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-2404-A, special authority is hereby granted to produce up to 500 MCF of gas per month from the above well until, (1) notice of release of "curtailment" shut-in is received from the Commission, or, (2) Notice of release of "six-times overproduced" shut-in appears in the monthly gas proration schedule.

Until Notice of Release of Shut-In is issued by the Commission, if more than 500 MCF of gas is produced during any month, the special authority granted by this order shall be automatically revoked and the above well shut in until all overproduction is made up.

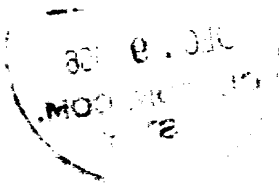

Reference is made to your application for a permit to produce gas from your lease in Block 1, Section 16, T12N, R10E, S10W, Kansas, and to the order of the Commission dated January 14, 1953, which is attached hereto.

By this order we under the provisions of order No. 10-100-1, special authority is hereby granted to produce gas from the above well until (1) a notice of release of gas is received from the operator, or (2) notice of release of "excess gas" is received from the operator, whichever occurs first. The notice of release of gas is to be reported to the Commission in the monthly gas production schedule.

Until notice of release of gas is received by the Commission, the production of gas from the above well shall not exceed the amount specified in the order. Any production in excess of the amount specified shall be considered as "excess gas" and shall be reported to the Commission in the monthly gas production schedule.

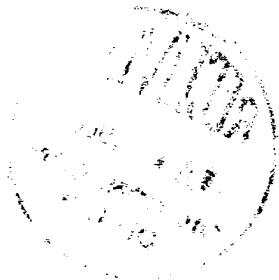
