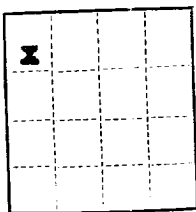

DETAILS OF WORK

Well Spudded March 20, 1953.

On March 21st - ran 6 joints - 8-5/8" 32# casing. 101 ft. Rotary Bushings.  
Cemented with 75 bags Longhorn cement. 100 lb. calcium chloride.  
Circulated to surface.

After waiting for cement to set, tested for water shut-off with 50 psig.  
Pressure held for 30 minutes with no indicated drop.

Drilling then continued with 7-7/8" bit.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
