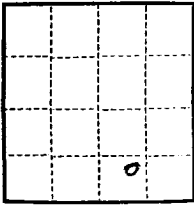

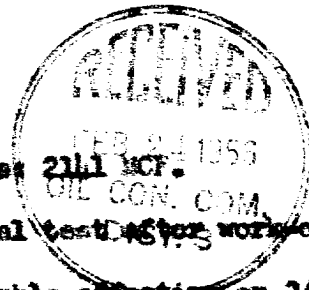

Fractured with 10,000 gal. diesel oil & 15,000# sand.

Pitot test for production before ~~start~~ ^{work-over:} 961 MCF; afterwards: 2111 MCF.

Annual deliverability test in 1/5a was 581 MCF/4.3%; annual test ~~after~~ ^{after work-over,} taken on 6/55, was 1340 MCF/3.7%, last figure being allowable effective on 2/1/56.
