DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill with rotary tools well of sufficient depth to test Pictured Cliff Formation at about 2,000 feet. Expect to set approximately 100 ft. of 8-5/8", 9-5/8", 10-3/4" or 13" surface casing, and approximately 1900 feet of 5 1/2" or 7" casing. If production probability exists from above formation, plan to shoot same with nitro-glycerin. Propose to drill in and complete with cable tools.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
