## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 23, 1950, more than 48 hours had elapsed since cementing the 5-1/2" casing at 2040' with 100 sacks of cement.

At that time, pipe was tested by bailing dry. Pipe remained dry 2 hours. Approximately 60' of solid cement was drilled in bottom of pipe and hole cleaned out to total depth.

Casing shut-off was considered satisfactory and completion operations have been resumed.
