DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded July 13, 1951. 105' of 3-1/2" casing was cemented with 60 sacks. On July 14th, prior to drilling plug, casing tested 100' at 70 minutes with no drop in pressure. Plug was drilled and fluid level was checked for 30 minutes with 600' with no drop.
