- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Products Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Frontier "B" Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of yas from an undesignated Dakota formation and the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup formation through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Gas Zone.
