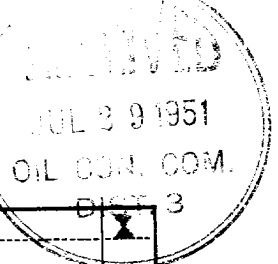

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded July 17, 1951. 90' of 3-5/8" casing was cemented with 30 sacks. On July 18th, prior to drilling plug, casing tested 500' for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Plug was drilled and fluid level was checked for 30 minutes with 500' with no drop.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
