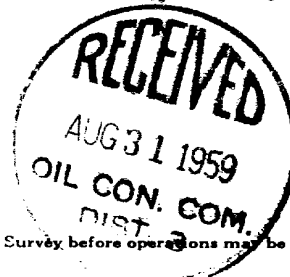

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Fred Fensel G #1 was spudded on 8-13-59 and on 8-15-59 9-5/8" casing was set at 367' with 190 sacks of cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement did not circulate. Recemented thru 1" outside casing with 95 sacks of cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated approximately 20 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing and water shut off with 500 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 367' and resumed drilling operations.
