Attec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the NW1 (or Lots 10, 11, 12, 13) of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:



- 1. That the Aztec-Hanks No. 2 Well, located 1650 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, was completed August 1, 1949 as a gas Well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on April 24, 1950.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 187.23 acres which are contiguous lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 5.
