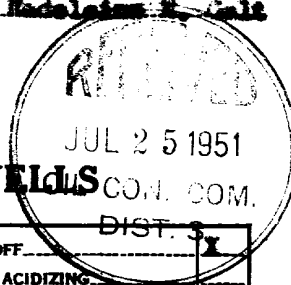

DETAILS OF WORK

On July 9, 1951, at 1:21 P.M., 5-1/2" casing was set at 1995' with 75 sacks cement. Rotary rig was moved off location and cable tool rig up for drilling cement plug and pay. On July 16, 1951, hole was bailed dry and remained dry for two hours. Twenty-seven feet of solid cement were then drilled in bottom of pipe and hole again bailed dry. Hole remained dry for two hours which was considered a satisfactory water shut-off test.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
