**DETAILS OF WORK**

Well was drilled to a total depth of 2132 feet with rotary tools. Cable tools moved on location and well cleaned out to bottom.

Well was plugged back with pea gravel from 2132 feet to 2072 feet and shot with 482 parts of 300 from 2072 to 2006, with 5 feet pea gravel top on top of shot on July 19, 1951. Well was cleaned out to 2102 feet. 1" tubing was landed at 2094 feet. Well was shut in 72 hours.

Well measured 648 MCF per day after 3 hour blow down through siphon string with pitot tube through 2" pipe nipple July 27, 1951.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
