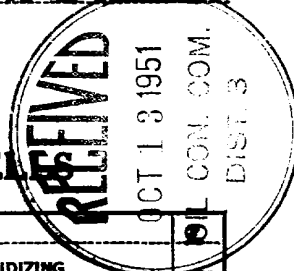

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was cased October 2, 1951.

On October 3, 1951, 10-3/4" casing was landed at 107 feet with 100 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface. Plug down at 9131 ft. on October 3, 1951. At 10:00 P.M., October 4, 1951, casing and water shut-off were tested with 300# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Thirty-five feet of solid cement was drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was tested with 400# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure during this test. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
