

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS HUERFANO UNIT WELL NO. 101 LOCATED IN THE SE/4 NW/4 OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE GALLUP FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE ANGELS PEAK-GALLUP OIL POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 22, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Huerfano Unit Well No. 101 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 19, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of March, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Huerfano Unit Well No. 101 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 19, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EXERCISE FULL CONVEYANCE OF THE HUNTSMAN UNIT WELL NO. 101 LOCATED IN THE SE1/4 NW1/4 OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 15 WEST, NMM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE GALLUP FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE ANGLES BEAK-GALLUP OIL POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 22, 1961, for permission to fully conveyance the Huntsmans Unit Well No. 101 located in the SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 19, Township 27 North, Range 15 West, NMM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Angles Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of March, 1961, the Secretary of the Commission finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of sub-section 'c' of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided and all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified and;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the time period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed full conveyance will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights;
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed well completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to fully conveyance the Huntsmans Unit Well No. 101 located in the SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 19, Township 27 North, Range 15 West, NMM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Angles Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of casing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.

to regular staple-crop production in the interests of conservation.
