Spudded 12-1/4" hole November 26, 1959, and drilled to 352'. 9-3/8" casing was set 352' with 200 sacks cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 800 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 352' and resumed drilling.
