March 15, 1956. After drilling to 2942' with rotary rig, (Top of Pictured Cliffs 2937') set 10 joints of 5-1/2" OD 15.5# casing and 61 joints 5-1/2" OD 14# casing at 2942' with 100 sacks cement. Moved off.

March 22, 1956. Moved in cable tools. Three hour test showed no water.

March 23, 1956. Sand oil treated from 2942' to 3007' with 17,000 gallons diesel oil, 30,000# sand and 15 gallons Hi-Flo. Flushed with 3,000 gallons diesel oil. Breakdown pressure 900#. Injection rate 45.1 barrels per minute.

March 24, 1956. Ran 120 joints (2994') of 1" tubing - landed at 3,007'. Shut in for potential test.

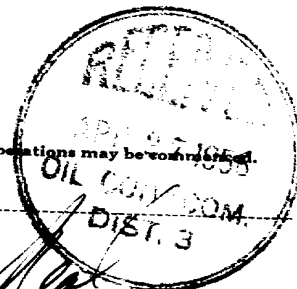
