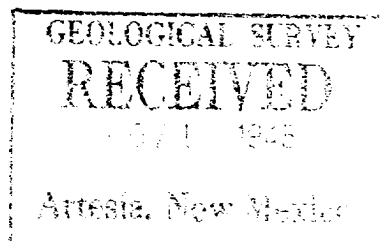
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5340 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK
