

THE APPLICATION OF AMOCO PRODUCTION  
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2913

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Amoco Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on July 16, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Jack Frost B Well No. 1-E located in Unit M of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of oil from the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool.

NOW, on this 11th day of August, 1981, the Division Director finds:

1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Amoco Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jack Frost B Well No. 1-E located in Unit M of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of oil from the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
