ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Southland Royalty Co. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on October 13, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Hanks Well No. 18-M located in Unit I of Section 5, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 9th day of November, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southland Royalty Co., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Hanks Well No. 18-M, located in Unit I of Section 5, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.



If, after said twenty-day eriod, no protest nor request for hearing is received by the Santa Fe office, the application will then be processed.

OTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard proration unit in one or more of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.
