The subject well is currently shut in. A deliverability test was performed on November 23, 1981. It is felt however, that this test is possibly inaccurate due to a large amount of completion fluid in the wellbore that had not been swabbed.

Therefore, we request permission to flare this well and perform another deliverability test to help expedite a pipeline connection. It is anticipated that a maximum of 600 MCFG will be flared while conducting the proposed 24 hour test. This test can be scheduled within one week after notification of approval.
