On November 6, 1992, the Schwerdtfeger Well No. 17-1 started a pump test. The test period ended on January 20, 1993. The average rates for the test period was 8 MCFPD and 13 BWPD with a tubing and casing pressure of 45 psig.

The well was shut-in and a replacement well, Schwerdtfeger 17-1R, was subsequently drilled and completed in December 1993 and January 1994 (NMOCD Order No. R-9987 and Case No. 10782). The well remains shut-in as a pressure monitoring well.
