On November 6, 1992, the Schwerdtfeger Well No. 17-1 started a pump test. The test period ended on January 20, 1993. The average rates for the test period was 8 MCFPD and 13 BWPD with a tubing and casing pressure of 45 psig.

The well was shut-in and a replacement well, Schwerdtfeger 17-1R, was subsequently drilled and completed in December 1993 and January 1994 (NMCD Order No. R-9987 and Case No. 10782). The well remains shut-in as a pressure monitoring well.

Dear Mr. Prosceno:

Reference is made to your well No. 1 Schwerdtfeger 17, 790' FNL & 1845' FEL Sec. 17, T. 27 N., R. 11 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, Lease NMSF-080382A and your Sundry Notice approved on October 19, 1992, which requested approval to test the well for 90 days to evaluate. If the test on the subject well has been completed you are required to submit a Subsequent Report and your plans. If the test has not been completed you are required to inform this office when the testing is scheduled to begin.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such requests, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20-business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the orders unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 *et seq.*
