Our files indicate that the Schwerdtfeger A #2, located 990 feet from the north and 990 feet from the west lines on Section 31, Township 31 north, Range 8 west was drilled to a toatl depth of 6770 feet on October 5, 1965, and $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch casing was cemented at 6770 feet with 1150 sacks of cement. On December 5, 1966, a notice of intention to drill was received for the Schwerdtfeger A #2X which is located 1190 feet from the north and 790 feet from the west lines of Section 31. On this form it was stated that the Schwerdtfeger A #2X was to be plugged and abandoned and the new well was to be drilled at the new location. The Schwerdtfeger A #2X was then successfully completed as a gas well in the Basin Dakota gas pool. We have never received a well record form relating to the #2X well, nor have we received copies of form 9-331 setting out the plugging details of the #2X well. Will you please send us copies of the above information?
