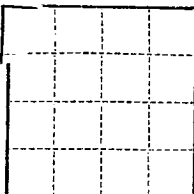

DETAILS OF WORK

On April 23, 1957, this well was spudded and on April 24, 1957, 8-1/8" casing was set at 142' with 190 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for 24 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 400 pounds pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

On April 27, 1957, 5-1/2" casing was landed at 2134 and cemented with 180 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for 4 days casing and cement were tested with 1000 pounds pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Completion operations were begun.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
