We note that you have submitted a gas well plat (C-128) with Notice of Intention to drill on your #3-C Storey well in the SE/4 Sec 33-T28N-R9W, dedicating the SE/4, being 175.68 acres.

Order R-565-C, Rule 6, stipulates that one standard gas proration unit shall consist of between 158 and 162 acres. Rule 6 (B) sets out the procedure necessary for securing administrative approval for non-standard units in the Astec Pool. We will be unable to approve Form 6-110 on this well until we have received administrative order approving your non-standard unit.

Order H-565-4, Rule 6, stipulates that one standard gas production unit shall consist of between 120 and 160 acres. Rule 6 (B) sets out the procedure necessary for securing administrative approval for non-standard units in the A-128 Pool. We will be unable to approve Form C-110 on this well until we have received administrative order approving your non-standard unit.
