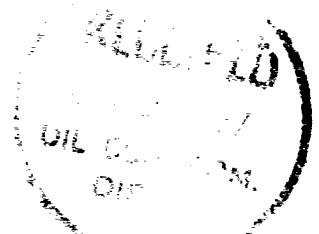

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Southeast quarter (SE/4) (or the N/2 of SE/4, lots 3 and 4) of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- in lot #4*
1. The Storey #3-C Well located 850' from the south line and 990' from the east line of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, was completed as a gas well on November 19, 1956, and has not as yet been connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system.
 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 175.68 acres which are contiguous quarter sections and lots.
 3. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
 5. That El Paso Natural Gas Company either holds operating rights or is sole working interest owner in all the land which lies contiguous to this quarter section in all directions, therefore, it is unnecessary according to regulations to send out any further letters of notification in regard to this matter other than to the Oil Conservation Commission.

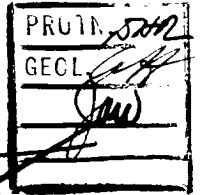

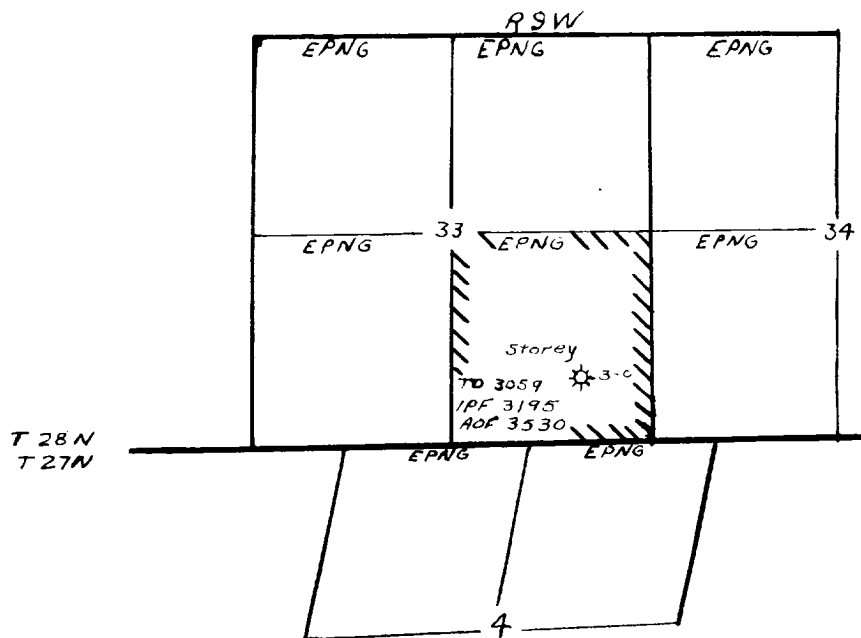
