THE APPLICATION OF ELPASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS STOREY WELL NO. 10-C (PM), LOCATED 1090 FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE AND 1650 FEET FROM THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 28 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN AN UNDESIGNATED PICTURED CLIFFS GAS POOL AND IN THE BLANCO MESAVERDE GAS POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on April 8, 1957, for permission to dually complete its Storey Well No. 10-C (PM), located 1090 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 35, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool and in the Blanco Mesa-verde Gas Pool.

The Secretary-Director Finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from all of the affected offset operators.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company be and it hereby is authorized to dually complete its Storey Well No. 10-C (PM), located 1090 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 35, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool through proper perforation of the casing and through the casing-tubing annulus, and the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool through proper perforation of the liner and through the tubing, with the installation of a suitable packer and with the installation of adequate surface equipment to maintain complete separation of the two zones of production.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That subject well shall be completed and thereafter produced in such a manner that there will be no commingling within the well-bore, either within or outside the casing of gas, oil and gas, or oil produced from either or both of the separate strata,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That prior to the actual dual completion the operator shall make pressure tests of the casing to prove that no casing leaks have developed since the well was originally completed. In the event a casing leak is apparent the operator shall take appropriate steps to adequately repair the leak. The results of these tests shall be reported to the Commission on Form C-103.

THE APPLICANT, BLANCO MESA VERDE GAS COMPANY, HAS REQUESTED PERMISSION TO EFFECT COMPLETION OF ITS STORMY WELL NO. 10-C (7M), LOCATED 1090 FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE AND 1050 FEET FROM THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 35 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, NEW MEXICO, SAN JUAN COUNTY, IN AN UNDESIGNATED PICTURED CLIFF GAS POOL AND IN THE BLANCO MESA VERDE GAS POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A (c) of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as April 4, 1957, for permission to drill and complete its stormy well No. 10-C (7M), located 1090 feet from the south line and 1050 feet from the west line of Section 35, Township 35 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool and in the Blanco Mesa Verde Gas Pool.

The Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section (c) of Rule 11-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset wells have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no material objection has been received from all of the affected offset operators.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, herein, BLANCO MESA VERDE GAS COMPANY, be and is hereby is authorized to drill and complete its stormy well No. 10-C (7M), located 1090 feet from the south line and 1050 feet from the west line of Section 35, Township 35 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool through proper perforation of the casing and through the casing-tubing annulus, and the production of gas from the Blanco Mesa Verde Gas Pool through proper perforation of the inner and through the tubing, with the installation of a suitable packer and with the installation of adequate surface equipment to maintain complete separation of the two zones of production.

PROVIDED HOWEVER: That subject well shall be completed and operated in such a manner that there will be no communication within the well-bore, either within or outside the casing of gas, oil and gas, or oil produced from either or both of the separate strata.

PROVIDED HOWEVER: That prior to the actual dual completion the operator shall make pressure tests of the casing to prove that no casing leaks have developed since the well was originally completed. In the event a casing leak is apparent the operator shall take appropriate steps to adequately repair the leak. The results of these tests shall be reported to the Commission on Form O-107.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well applicant shall submit to the appropriate District Office of the Commission, copies of Oil Conservation Commission Form C-103, Form C-104, Form C-110 and Form C-122 outlining the information required on those forms by existing Rules and Regulations and two copies of the electric log of the well.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That said subject well for dual completion and production shall be equipped in such a way that reservoir pressures may be determined separately for each of the two specified strata, and further, be equipped with all necessary connections required to permit recording meters to be installed and used, at any time, as may be required by the Commission or its representatives, in order that natural gas, oil, or oil and gas from each separate stratum may be accurately measured and the gas-oil ratio thereof determined, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the operator-applicant shall make any and all tests, including segregation tests and packer leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the deliverability test period for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, but not excluding other tests and/or determinations at any convenient time and in such manner as deemed necessary by the Commission; the original and all subsequent tests shall be witnessed by representatives of the Commission and by representatives of offset operators if any there be, at their election, and the results of each test properly attested to by the applicant herein and all witnesses, and shall be filed with the Commission within fifteen (15) days after completion of such test, and further that operator shall submit a packer-setting affidavit within fifteen days of completion and after remedial work whenever the packer is disturbed, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well, applicant shall submit to the Commission a diagrammatic sketch of the mechanical installation which was actually used to complete and produce the seal between the strata, and a special report of production, gas-oil ratio and reservoir pressure determination of each producing zone or stratum immediately following completion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.

 oil ratio and reservoir pressure determination of each producing zone or
 stratum has actually following completion.

It is further ordered, That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and for protection of correlative rights upon intake of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular rights-zone production in the waterless conservation.
