Reference is made to your application for approval of a 338.45-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Storey Well No. 9-C, located 1700 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 34, Township 28 North, Range 9 West.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1 (b) Section 15 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-128-D, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 338.45 acres.
