5/20 to 5/25 - Intermitting 30 minutes every 12 hours to clean out water.

5/25 - Connected well to El Paso Natural Gas Co. pipeline.

Dear Frank:

I am writing you with reference to The No. 1 Cole well, located in the NWSE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35 T28N, R10W, San Juan County N. M. which is being scheduled for testing in the near future.

If the above well is shut in for a period exceeding two days, it will log off and have to be swabbed back in to get it to producing again.

I have had a lot of problems with this well in the last couple of years and think we have learned how to keep it producing, provided that we can keep it on the line. It is classified as stripper production. If you can do anything to get us an exemption from shutting it in I would appreciate it very much. I have had a swabbing unit on this well for a total of at least 15 or 20 days this year and can't afford much more of that.
