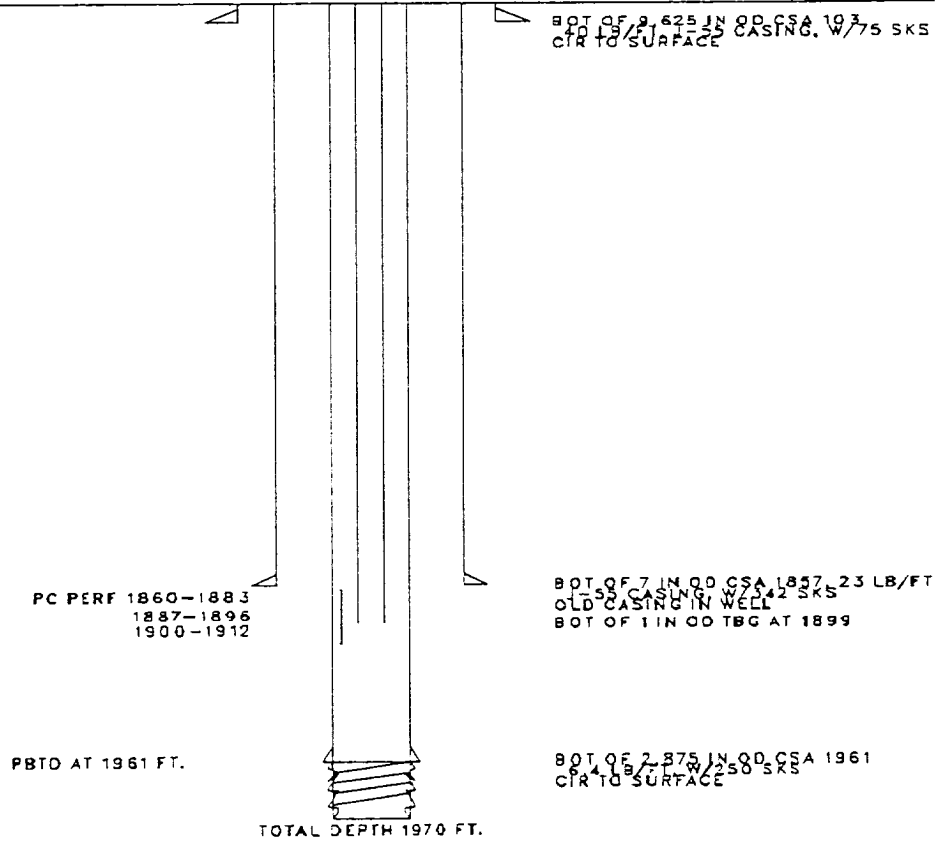

PXA Procedures
Cole #1

1. Check location for anchors. Install if necessary. Test anchors.
2. MIRUSU. Blow down well. Kill if necessary with fresh water.
3. POOH with 1" tbg. NDWH. NUBOP. RIH with tbg and cement retainer. Set retainer at 1800'. Test casing integrity to 500#.
4. Squeeze perfs at 1850' to 1912' with 44.939 cuft cement. Pull out of retainer and spot a cement plug to surface with 87.75 cuft cement.
5. NDBOP. Cut off casing and wellhead. Install PXA marker according to BLM or State requirements.
6. Turn over to John Schwartz for reclamation.
7. Rehabilitate location according to BLM or State requirements.
