5 1/2" liner at 5504' with 300 sacks cement.

The N/2 of Section 34 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde.

The NE/4 of Section 34 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs.

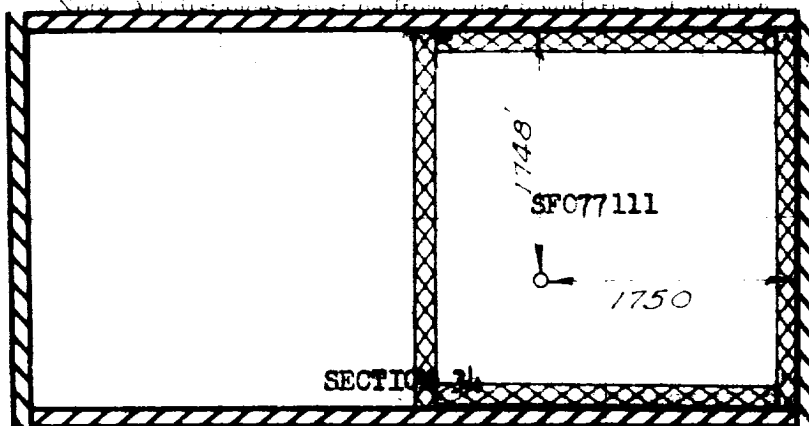
