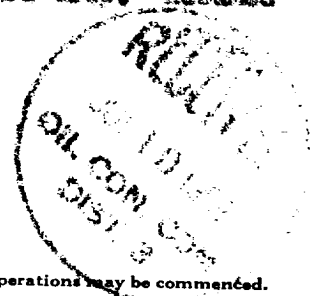

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

On June 28, 1959, 4-1/2" casing was set at 5602 and cemented in two stages.
First Stage: 375 sacks 5% gel cement mixed with 1-1/2 pounds tuf-plug per sack followed by 100 sacks neat cement, with staging tool set at 2142, cemented
Second Stage with 300 sacks 4% gel cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 2500 psi for 30 minutes with no indicated pressure drop. Resumed completion operations.
