DETAILS OF WORK

July 10, 1952. Total depth 5100'.

Ran 22 joints of 5½" 15.5# J-55 casing (656') set at 5049' with 50 sacks regular cement and hung at 4393'. Casing was run as a liner with the collars and threads cut off, the joints being welded together.

Top of cement by temperature survey @ 4640'.
