Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Daum Well No. 4 (PM) to be located 1090 feet from the North line and 2240 feet from the East line and in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as there are no other affected offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Section 1 (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-110 as amended by Order R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Section 1 (c) of Order R-110 as amended by Order R-397 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
